

ENVIRONMENTAL STATEMENT

Basic Philosophy

DID recognizes that conservation of the global environment is one of the most important issues common to all humankind, and the whole organization of DID will endeavor to reduce environmental load and protect the environment.

Principles

In order to reduce environmental effects resulting from any of our activities, products and services related to processing and sales of electronic parts including wires and cables, DID will promote environmental management activities based on the principles described below, and pursue harmonization with the global environment.

- 1 DID will always maintain awareness of the environmental effects resulting from our activities, products and services, pursue prevention of environmental pollution and conservation of the environment, and continuously improve environmental management activities. Here, conservation of the environment includes sustainable use of resources, mitigation of climate change and adaptation to climate change.
- 2 DID will comply with environmental laws and other requirements pertaining to our activities, products and services.
- 3 DID will promote the following actions as primary environmental management measures for the environmental effects resulting from our activities, products and services.
 - (1) Reducing the amount of waste
 - (2) Cleaning up the streets around our offices
 - (3) Reducing packaging materials
 - (4) Reducing waste bags
 - (5) Reducing combustible waste
 - (6) Improving fuel efficiency
 - (7) Promoting power saving
- 4 DID will take steps to ensure that all staff are familiar with this Environmental Statement so that they can take positive actions to reduce environmental load, and also to ensure that the Statement is available to the public.
- 5 DID will actively take part in implementing measures for environmental improvement in the local community.

In order to meet the foregoing principles, DID will set goals, review them periodically, and promote the environmental management system.
